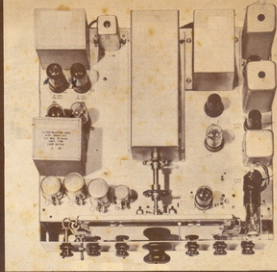

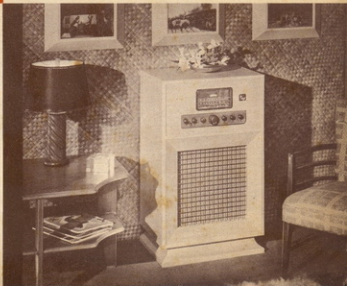
*And it possesses all these important features:*

- 1 Twelve tubes, of latest type, including tuning indicator and rectifier in a powerful superheterodyne circuit.
- 2 105/125 volts 25/60 cycles AC-DC operation. Optional step-down transformer available for 210-240 volts AC operation. Also resistance network for 220 volts DC.
- 3 Three short-wave bands from 3.2 to 23.4 MC (about 13 to 94 m.) in addition to regular broadcast band from 540 to 1600 KC (190 to 555 m.). Highly efficient bandspread on short waves.
- 4 Extremely high sensitivity with relatively low noise level. Noise limiter switch.
- 5 Amazingly lifelike reproduction for such a type of set, without appreciable attenuation to 12000 cycles. Continuously variable tone control.
- 6 Separate highest grade permanent magnet 12-inch dynamic speaker to handle smoothly the maximum output of receiver.
- 7 Battleship construction of the finest parts obtainable, insuring virtually trouble-free service for many years.
- 8 Superb radio cabinet of modernistic line constructed by master furniture makers in rich limed oak finish that will add charm to the most luxurious decorating scheme.
- 9 Continuously variable sensitivity control as well as separate selectivity control to permit optimum reception of distant stations.
- 10 Attractive rule-type precision dial, with accurate logging dial, for extreme ease in tuning.
- 11 Provision for phonograph pickup attachment. High impedance type.
- 12 Balanced phase inverter, inverse feedback, push-pull beam power output circuit.

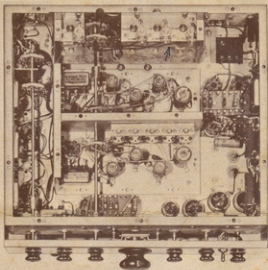
